The Program

- The second international LEAD Summer School will take place on **August 05 – August 09, 2019** in Berlin
- Prior to the actual event, all participants complement our obligatory 5-weeks online program "Leading in the digital Age".
- In Berlin we are hosted at the beautiful venue "Spreespeicher".
- The participants will be around 90 leaders from all sectors and from all over the world.
- The Summer School starts with a leadership and networking conference.
- For each day, participants can choose 1 out of 4 trainings

How to participate

The participation fee is **€ 3.200** per person and includes lunch, dinner and drinks. Travel and lodging are not included. Thanks to the support of American Express, LEAD offers a limited number of partial scholarships for participants from non-profit and public sector organizations.

Tracks and Trainings

Each day will cover one of the four tracks LEAD has identified as being crucial for successful leadership in the digital age.
